PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

Player's responsibilities are simple; be respectful of others, be responsible, be honest, play fair, do your best, and always exhibit good sportsmanship. The essential elements of character-building and ethics in sports are embodied in the concept of sportsmanship and six core principles: Trustworthiness, Respect, Responsibility, Fairness, Caring, and Good Citizenship. The highest potential of sports is achieved when competition reflects these “six pillars of character.”

As a Sprague Little League (SLL) participant, players are required to:

- Encourage good sportsmanship from fellow players, coaches, officials, and parents.
- Be a team player and support teammates.
- Be on time and attend every practice and game when able.
- Work hard to improve skills.
- Do your best to listen and learn from coaches.
- Congratulate the other team after each game as a demonstration of sportsmanship.
- Refrain from using violence, unfriendly language, or insults to others.
- Be generous when you win and gracious when you lose.
- Obey the rules of the game and always work for the good of the team.
- Accept the decisions of the officials with grace and never challenge or question calls.
- Conduct yourself with honor and dignity.
- Applaud the efforts of your teammates and opponents.

If a participant fails to abide by these rules & guidelines, they will be subject to disciplinary action by the SLL Board of Directors or Code of Conduct Committee that could include, but is not limited to, the following:

- Verbal warning
- Written warning
- Player suspension for games
- Player suspension for season including postseason (All Stars & TOC)
- Player being expelled from the league

The SLL Board of Directors retains the sole authority to determine what, if any, disciplinary action is appropriate for any conduct infraction.
